Macoun-Hill Award

The Macoun-Hill Graduate Student Travel Awards are being given to CSHS member students who are attending a conference where CSHS is a sponsoring society. Previously, it was awarded to the best published horticultural paper in the Canadian Journal of Plant Science (CJPS).

About the award: The award was started by Dr. Charles Eaves (1908-2006) a Post-Harvest Physiologist at AAFC Kentville Research Station in memory of Drs. W.T. Macoun and Hinson Hill (see below). Dr. Eaves made the initial donation of \$1000 which was match by Mr. David Hill (son of Dr. Hill) and he has made further donations since the inception. Currently, the funds (about \$11 000) for the award are in investments.

Dr. W. T. Macoun (William Terrill, 1869-1933) was a horticulturalist at the Dominion Experimental Farm from 1898-1910 and served as the Dominion Horticulturalist from 1911-1932.

He was the son of John Macoun a botany professor and a surveyor for the westward extension of the Canadian Pacific Railway with Sanford Fleming.

As the Dominion Horticulturalist he oversaw 24 experimental farms and stations in Canada. Macoun received the Carter Gold Medal for Advancement of Horticulture. He was a founder of the Ontario Horticultural Association as served as the president of the Ottawa Horticultural Society.

A search of Macoun's publications indicated his varied interests. His publications cover the culture of small fruit, hardy rose, apple and potato. He also published on plant pathology and grafting.

W. T. Macoun passed away in August 1933. A W.T. Macoun memorial fund was supported by 47 Horticultural Societies with donations. The fund was used to build ornamental garden on the site of Dr. Macoun's residence at the Experimental farm.

Dr. Hinson Hill was born in Valleyfield, Quebec on May 12, 1902 the second of three children born to William and Sarah Hill. His father and mother had immigrated to Canada from Lancashire, England. His father worked in the textile mills in Valleyfield until his death.

Hinson Hill attended MacDonald College of McGill University receiving the degrees of Bachelor of Science in Agriculture (BSA) in 1925 and Master of Science (MSc) in 1927. In 1938 he obtained a Doctorate in Plant Physiology at the University of London, England.

Dr. Hill joined the Canada Department of Agriculture in 1924 as a potato inspector in the Maritimes, based in Prince Edward Island. In 1927 he became Senior Horticulturist in the former Experimental Farm Service and moved to Ottawa where he made his home until his death. In 1955 Dr. Hill was appointed Chief, Horticulture Division, Canada Department of Agriculture, a position that until just before his appointment had the title of Dominion Horticulturist. With the reorganization of the Department of Agriculture in 1959, Dr. Hill was appointed to the position of Associate Director (Horticulture) in the Program Directorate of the Research Branch, Canada Department of Agriculture which position he held until his death.

Dr. Hill's specialized field of research was in plant nutrition as applied to horticultural crops and in this specialty he gained international recognition and was a widely published author of research papers (some alone and some in combination with Dr. M. B. Davis, Dr. Fred B. Johnston, Dr. E. P. Grant, Dr. W. A. Roach, Dr. Hugh B. Cannon, Dr. H. B. Heeney, Dr. W. W. Buckmaster, Dr. R. F. Bishop, Dr. A. B. Durkee, Dr. G. N. Ward and Dr. C. A. Eaves). He was an active member of his profession and held the following professional positions: Fellow, American Association for the Advancement of Science (F.A.A.A.S.); Official Correspondent of the Commonwealth Bureau of Horticulture and Plantation Crops; Honorary President, The Western Society for Horticultural Science; Member, American Society for Horticultural Science; Member, Canadian Society for Horticultural Science.

Dr. Hill married Gertrude Bathgate in Ottawa in 1929 and they had one child, David Hinson Hill, born in 1939.

Dr. Hill was killed in a traffic accident in Vanderhoof, British Columbia, in 1959 while on an inspection trip of western research stations of the Department of Agriculture.
